

How to use the Factory Restore DVD

Running the Factory Restore Disk will **ERASE ALL DATA** and **APPLICATIONS** that were installed onto the system after the unit has left the factory. We are not responsible for any data loss that may occur.

1. Insert the Factory Restore DVD into your DVD drive. Set your system so that it boots from the optical Drives first. For more information, please find the technical support section in this manual.
2. When the PC starts to boot to DVD, it will ask if you to press any key to boot from CD-Rom. Press any key.
3. The restore DVD will auto run, and prompt you, "Are you sure you want to restore?", Click on "OK".
4. For safety, you will be asked prompted again with the following message:

"RESTORE PARTITION WILL PERMANENTLY DELETE ALL DATA FROM THE PARTITION/HARD DRIVE. ARE YOU SURE YOU WANT TO RESTORE?"

5. If you are sure, click on "OK" to start the recovery process.
6. Once the recovery process is complete, you will see a "Restore Complete" message.
7. Remove the DVD from the drive, and Click on "Quit". The system will automatically reboot.

Your computer has been restored to the factory standard settings.
